


SAMSUNG SMART TV

Turn on the TV and use the arrow cursors on the remote to select the streaming service you want to use. Follow the instructions for signing in to your account. We have Netflix, Hulu, Prime, & Disney uploaded. Please sign out of your account before leaving.

If you do not have an account to any of the streaming services, you have access to Samsung TV. The button on the remote that says GUIDE gives you information about what programming is accessible via Samsung TV.

Please note that you may have issues with the internet during inclement weather, which will affect your ability to use the Smart TVs.



COFFEE MAKER

1. To brew a single cup, lift the silver handle to insert the pod. Then close the handle. Press the power button. The POD & CARAFE buttons will blink. Select POD, then select your brew size. Double-click the silver "K" button to start brewing. For a bolder coffee, press the STRONG button before brewing.

2. To brew a carafe, fill the water reservoir in the back of the machine to the MAX fill line. Lift the filter basket cover & insert a filter. 4 filters have been provided for you in the "Coffee" jar. Add the desired amount of ground coffee – 1 tablespoon per cup is recommended. Close the filter basket cover completely and make sure the carafe is on the heating plate. Press the power button. The POD & CARAFE buttons will blink. Select CARAFE, then select your brew size. Double-click the silver "K" button to start brewing.

Once the brew is complete, the heating plate will automatically turn on for two hours - the CARAFE button will illuminate red to show it's on. To turn off the heating plate, press and hold the CARAFE button until the light is no longer illuminated. If you accidentally shut the heating plate off, press and hold the CARAFE button until the red light illuminates to turn it back on.

A coffee bean grinder is in the cabinet under the coffee machine. Sugar packets are provided in the "Sugar" jar and tea bags are in the "Tea" jar.

HOT TUB

Lift the cover. Fold the cover on the left side. Then lift both side of the cover to the right. To close the cover, push in the red button on the pole that holds the cover. Then push to the left and unfold & it should close easily. It will not close unless the red button is pushed. Please do not force it.


Use the arrow buttons to adjust the temperature. To turn the jets on in the back of the hot tub, press the button on the top left. To turn the jets on in the front of the hot tub, press the button on the bottom left. Press the lighting button to turn on the lights.



FIRE TABLE

To turn the gas-powered fire table on, push and hold the igniter button to create sparks. The igniter button is on the right side of the controls, directly on the fire table.. While holding the igniter button, **push and hold** the control knob to the LOW position to light the burner. If ignition does not occur in five seconds, push and turn the control knob to OFF, wait five minutes and allow gas to dissipate. Once the burner is lit, continue to hold the control knob in for another 20 seconds and release. If igniter will not light the burner, you can use a long match or extended butane lighter.

To turn the gas table off, push and turn the control knob clockwise to the off position.





SONOS SPEAKERS

To connect to the Sonos speakers, which are placed throughout the cabin & on the porch, please download the the Sonos app on your phone. Please make sure you are connected to the Wi-Fi. When you open the Sonos app, it will say "Control audio on a nearby Sonos system." Press that button. Then, buttons for each of the speakers throughout the cabin will appear. They will be labeled on the app according to which room they are in. If you go to the home screen of the app by pressing the STAR, in the bottom left menu of the screen, you can then connect to your preferred streaming music account.

WINERIES & VINEYARDS



ARTS & CULTURE







Please wash & put away all dishes. Please load any dirty dishes into the dishwasher & start the dishwasher.



















